First Place Largemouth Bass GALE WATSON (NS) 10 pounds, 2 ounces



First Place Crappie FRANK GAGLIANO (WM) Two pounds, ten ounces




On May 4th while fishing in the late afternoon, TUFF member Frank caught a spawning female 14.5 inch by fat 12 inch girth crappie.
